MASTER CATTLEMEN SERIES


The Heartland Master Cattlemen program will start on February 20th. **This program counts for CAIP educational credit.** Please give us a call/text to sign up 270-765-4121.

BQCA TRAININGS

Beef Quality and Care Assurance training is recommended for all cattle producers. It is also required for some investment areas of the CAIP program. The cost for the training is \$5 and checks need to be made out to "Kentucky Beef Network". There will be two opportunities for BQCA training. Wednesday, January 31st at 8:30 a.m. and Tuesday, February 6th at 6:00 p.m. We are also working on a BQA program with Certified Angus Beef that will be a handson training program.
