#### **CAMP FEES BY AGE:**

CAMPERS FEES FOR AGE 9-14 & CIT'S - \$200 JR. TEEN COUNSELORS (AGE 15) - \$100 TEEN COUNSELORS (AGE 16-17) - \$100 ADULT COUNSELORS (AGES 18 & UP) - FREE

Approved adult counselors may take one child at no cost, however a \$50 registration fee will be refunded after camp has concluded.

#### **CAMPER PAYMENT OPTIONS:**

- **PAYMENT PLAN** 5 payments of \$40 each from January—May (Must start payment plan no later than January 31, 2024.) Payments must be made monthly by the last day of the month.

(recipe makes 1 serving)

#### **Ingredients:**

1/3 cup oatmeal (dry, quick-cooking)

1/8 teaspoon salt

3/4 cup water (very hot)

1/2 banana (sliced)

1/2 cup light strawberry yogurt

#### **Directions:**

- 1. Wash hands with warm water and soap, scrubbing for at least 20 seconds.
- 2. In a microwave safe bowl, mix 1/3 cup oatmeal and 1/8 teaspoon salt.
- 3. Add 3/4 cup hot water, and stir to combine.
- 4. Microwave on high power for 1 minute.
- 5. Remove the bowl with oven mitts, and stir.
- 6. Microwave on high power for another 1 minute. Remove the bowl with oven mitts, stir, then allow it to cool slightly to thicken.
- 7. Using a cutting board and knife, slice half of a peeled banana. Wrap, and eat the remaining banana half as a morning snack later that day.
- 8. Top the oatmeal with banana slices and 1/2 cup yogurt.
- 9. Serve immediately.
